A quick look at the Electronic Reading Aid (ERA)



- 1. Magnify
- 2. Mode
- 3. Freeze & D-freeze
- 4. De-magnify
- 5. Power on/off
- 6. Power indicator
- 7. Y-shaped power/video cable

How to use the ERA?

- Insert the small end of the power adaptor into the black end of the Y-shaped power/video cable from the Reading Aid.
- 2. Plug the power adaptor into a wall socket.
- Insert the yellow RCA plug on the video cable into one of your television's yellow video input connectors. Refer to your television owner's manual for more information locating these connectors.
- 4. Turn on the television. If necessary, switch your television to the appropriate input channel.
- 5. Turn on the ERA by sliding the on/off button to ON position. Then the power indicator will light.
- 6. Put the ERA on newspapers, magazine etc and then you can read their big images from TV. Now you can enjoy your reading.

- 7. Key definitions:
 - M: Switch reading mode among Full color, Black on White, White on Black, Yellow on Black, Blue on Yellow, Blue on White, Yellow on Bl
 - 2) +: Magnify
 - 3) -: De-magnify
 - 4) *: Freeze & D-freeze

Safety:

The ERA is not waterproof, so keep it dry.

- Use the ERA only at -5°C-50°C.
- The white LEDs which illuminate the ERA target field are very bright. Do not stare directly into these LEDs as it may damage your eyes.
- Use only the power adaptor that came with the ERA. Other adaptors may damage the unit.
